

## Fitting the Quick ON cover



1. Place the sheet with the label: "This side up..." towards the head rest.



2. Place the Quick ON on top of the mattress and fold the stretch sheet down around its corners.



3. The Quick ON has now been tightly fitted around the mattress.

## **Turning in bed**



4. The user bends their right leg or both legs and grips the bed guard on the opposite side with their right hand or the other way around for turning to the right side.



5. The user can now move their pelvis backwards and easily slide onto their side by pulling with their right arm and lowering their right leg against the bedding.

## Transferring to sitting position on the edge of the bed



6. The user turns to side lying position close to the edge of the bed.
The user then elevates the bed's headboard.



7. The user pushes with the hands against the head end of the bed and simultaneously slides the legs forwards over the edge of the bed to reach the sitting position.
