#### The intended use of the product/-s:

#### One Time Cover and One Time Turn Sheet:

The product is a Single Patient Use Turning system which reduces friction between the user and the mattress to make it easier for the helper and gentler for the user whilst turning in the bed. The One Time Turning Sheet should always be used in combination with a One Time Cover or a Mattress Cover from master care a/s.

#### One Time Lift:

The product is a combined Single Patient Use Lifting Sling and Turning system which reduces friction between the user and the mattress, making it easier for the helper and more gently for the user whilst turning in the bed. This product should always be used in combination with a One Time Cover or a Mattress Cover from master care a/s. The product should not be used if it is or has been wet since this degrades the breaking strength of the product.

#### **Correct use of the product:**

The products are particularly suitable for users and in situations with a big risk of infection or e.g., outpatient departments.

#### Warning:

The product should not be used if it is or has been wet since this degrades the breaking strength of the product.

#### **Risk assessment:**

Always make a risk assessment and a functional assessment of the user prior to using the product. This way using the product for transferring or moving a user, is ergonomic and legally sound.

#### Knowledge of the product/transferring:

It is important that the user of the product has been properly instructed in the use of the product and has read the user manual thoroughly prior to using the product.

#### Life span:

The product is a Single Patient Use (SPU) product which should only be used for the same patient/user. The product withstands to be damp and a light wet wipers but can't substant washing in a washing machine

If the product is polluted the user/helper must evaluate when to discard the product.

Products with insufficient friction reduction, defect seams, broken material or other deficiencies must be discarded. This way you will always keep a sound and healthy work environment for both helper and user.

Make visual inspections frequently and preferably before every use.

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#### Fitting the One Time Turn Sheet & Mattress Cover:



1. Place the One Time mattress cover with the label by the head section of the mattress and fold the stretch sheet down around the four corners of the mattress.



2. The One Time mattress cover fits tightly around the mattress.



3. Place the One Time turn sheet on top of the mattress cover.

#### Turning in bed manually (2 helpers):



4. Bend the user's legs. Guide the user's hand to the opposite shoulder. Push the pillow to the side to which the user is turning.



5. One helper pulls the user towards himself using the Turning Sheet while the other pushes the user slightly to the side.



6. If the user isn't lying stable in the side position the helper can use the One Time Turning Sheet to push the user to a stable position.

#### Turning in bed with a lift (1-2 helpers):



7. Cross the user's legs and move the pillow to the side to which the user is being turn to. Attach the Turning sheet's straps to the lift.



8. Elevate the user slightly. The assistant pushes the userbackwards in the bed. Use the Master Comfort Stomach Wedge to provide greater support and comfort during turning.



9. Raise the lift. The user is turned onto the side.



#### To sitting position on the edge of the bed:



10. The user activates the bed's knee bending function.



11. The user then elevates the bed's headboard.



12. Due to the smooth silk layer, the user can now easily rotate to a sitting position whilst moving their legs over the edge of the bed.

#### Sitting position in bed:



13. Make sure that the user's hip is aligned with the beds hip angle.

The assistant elevates the middle section of the bed under the user's knees.



14. The assistant elevates the head section. The user may use the sliding ability of the satin to position the pelvic. For repositioning of the back move in a diagonal direction.

#### Transfer using a Hoist ONLY for the One Time Lift:



15. Ensure that the user's hip is placed correctly in the bed. Activate the middle section and then the head section.



16. Mount the straps on the lift yoke — use the inner straps on top and the outer straps on the lower part.



17. Use the lift to place the user in the wheel-chair.



#### Lifting to the wheelchair ONLY for the One Time Lift:



18. Tilt the wheelchair back. Lower the back of the wheelchair so the user can move properly back into the seat. If needed place a piece of antislide on the seat.



19. Mount the straps on the lift yoke — use the inner straps on top and the outer straps on the lower part. Lift the user to the wheelchair.



20. Smoothen the fabric under the user. Fold the One Time Lift down along the side of the user. Fold it inwards to keep the surface smooth. The turn sheet is now comfortably folded away but easy to pull out if there is a need for lifting.

Make sure that all relevant brakes are activated before transferring the user.


