The intended use of the product/-s:

The product is used to support and reduce pressure on the tissue while repositioning a user or when lying in bed. Wedges with anti-slide on the underside can be used directly on slippery surfaces.

Correct use of the product:

The Master Comfort products can be placed between the user and the area of support and thereby reduce the pressure on the skin. Alternatively, the products can be used to support the sitting position or when lying on the side to prevent falling forward or backwards.

Warning:

The use of pillows and wedges can't replace the need of frequent repositioning and daily skin assessment.

Risk assessment:

Always make a risk assessment and a functional assessment of the user prior to using the product. This way using the product for transferring or moving a user, is ergonomic and legally sound.

Knowledge of the product/transferring:

It is important that the user of the product has been properly instructed in the use of the product and has read the user manual thoroughly prior to using the product.

User Manual - Master Positioning Comfort Cushions

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Supporting upper leg when side lying (Passive user, one helper):



1. The user is lying on the back on a Master Turner or a Light Turner. Place the chosen Cushion next to the legs.



2. Fold a Nylon Master Open and place it with the fold between the user's legs. A Positioning Wedge - S MC 001-8035 can be used to support the stomach.



3. Turn the user to side lying position using a ceiling hoist and the Master or Light Turner. The Turn Sheet turns the legs automatically.



4. Use the folded Nylon Master Open to slide the upper leg into position on top of the Positioning Cushion. It can be an advantage to use a Leg Strap or a Master Grip to "extend" the arms reach if the upper legs is positioned far away.



5. Remove the Nylon Master Open by pulling the lower part of the sliding material. If it gets stuck pull from the opposite lower corner. It is a good idea to stabilize the top leg while pulling the Nylon Master to keep it in position.



6. Make sure the leg is supported and stabilized comfortably. A sheet can be placed on top to avoid direct contact between Cushion and bare skin.

Avoid sliding downwards in bed in sitting position (Passive user, one helper):



7. The user is lying on a Master Turner. Make sure the user's pelvis is placed in the correct position in the bed. Preferably use the two Positioning Wedges - XS to maintain this position. Fully elevate the knee-bend of the bed.



8. Place the chosen Positioning Cushion under the users feet. Elevate the head-end of the bed. Because of the unique sliding abilities of the Master Turner the user can move/be moved around but feels no shear or tear of the skin. The Positioning Cushion helps to prevent the user from sliding down. The feet should be supported comfortably and not restrained.



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Supporting the arm/-s in sitting poition:



9. Choose the appropriate Positioning Cushion. Lift the user's arm and place the Cushion. Position the arm comfortably on top of the Positioning Cushion.



10. Often it is more comfortable to have both arms supported at the same time. This way the body is stimulated equally on both sides while being relaxed and stabile.



11. As an accessory a cotton cover is available.

Minimizing tissue injuries:



12. To avoid tissue injuries our Positioning Cushion contains small Original Krøyer Balls. They are easy to mold out and shape to support the body in the perfect way. Hence the weight on the tissue is distributed on a bigger area and thereby reducing the risk of tissue injuries. On top of this the balls are flame retardant and washable.


