The intended use of the product/-s:

The products can be used by people who have impaired or partial impaired capacity to change body position due to restricted movement or body perception damage and therefore are unable to provide a stable body positioning without support. Furthermore, the products can prevent/ reduce injuries caused by pressure or shearing forces for users who are in risk of pressure or shear ulcers.

The products can also have a stabilizing and calming effect on people with sensory or cognitive impairments and have a pain-relieving effect.

The products increase the support surface, which gives a better distribution of the pressure on the tissue thereby reducing the risk of pressure injuries.

Proper use of the product:

The Master Comfort products can be placed between the user and the area of support and thereby reduce the pressure on the skin. Alternatively, the products can be used to support the sitting position or when lying on the side to prevent falling forward or backwards.

Indications:

The product is suitable for users with impaired physical and/or cognitive function who need support in a lying position. It can also be used to help prevent pressure ulcers in the user.

Warning:

It is very important for the patient to reposition themselves, or is repositioned, on a regular basis. This relieves pressure which helps prevent both tissue compression and potential pressure injury formation. Skin redness is one clinical indicator for skin breakdown. Regularly inspect/monitor if your skin develops any redness. Contact a healthcare professional immediately, if the skin develops redness.

Risk assessment:

Always make a risk assessment and a functional assessment of the user prior to using the product. This way using the product for transferring or moving a user, is ergonomic and legally sound.

Knowledge of the product/transferring:

It is important that the user of the product has been properly instructed in the use of the product and has read the user manual thoroughly prior to using the product.

Life span:

The expected life span of the products is 1 - 5 years depending on the use. user's load and how often it is washed and dried.

Placing the Master Comfort Sleep:



1. Master Comfort Sleep provides a stabile positioning in bed. Can be placed either in front of the body or behind the back and legs. The top can be used as a pillow.



2. Place the Master Comfort Sleep behind the user's head, back and under the upper leg.



3. The lower part of the Master Comfort Sleep can be modulated to give optimal support to the upper leg or be placed between the legs to provide pressure relief.

Seated positioning:



4. Master Comfort Sleep can be used to support/increase body perception and awareness to the upper body when in supine lying. Place it like a "U" along the upper body and behind the head.



5. Place the middle of Master Comfort Sleep under the head. Leave the Bed Rail up to keep the Krøyer balls in place.



6. Place and adjust the left and right side of Master Comfort Sleep along the body. Adjust the balls to comfortably support the forearms and hands.

Cover:



7. The Master Comfort Sleep is delivered with a incontinence surfase. The fabric is stretchable and has a long durability. It can be cleaned with soap and water or with alcohol.



8. A soft, comfortable and washable cover is available to protect the cushion.



9. Master Comfort Sleep consistes of real Krøyer balls which addabed to the body and give the body a sense of stability and a good pressure relief.

The Blue Cover can be washed in a washing machine at max. 85 °C. Lower washing tempeture will prolong the durability. The Master Comfort Sleep can be disinfection with alchohol - do not wash it in a washing machine.



Detergents pH level:

Fabric softener:

Never use fabric softener as this will reduce the sliding properties significantly.

The Blue Cover may only be dry tumbled gently and at max. 40 °C.

The surface of this product can be cleaned with a wet cloth and soap.



Disinfectants:

The Master Comfort Sleep tolerates alcoholic disinfectants with a pH level between 5-9.



Ironing:

Do not iron.
